Electrician

Working on a three-shift rotation to support manufacturing operations, you will assemble, install, test, repair, replace, and maintain electrical or electronic wiring, equipment, appliances, apparatuses, and fixtures, using hand tools and power tools. You will also diagnose malfunctioning systems and apparatuses as well as test/inspect electrical systems, equipment, and components to identify hazards, defects, and the need for adjustment or repair, and to ensure compliance with codes. Computer proficient, you have experience reading automation wiring diagrams and troubleshooting systems and circuits. To support factory automation equipment, experience with the following would be beneficial: Allen Bradley PLCs, safety PLCs, and VFDs (multiple generations, Mitsubishi and Siemens PLCs, and related equipment); Device Net, RIO, and Ethernet; robotics (Nachi primarily; experience with KUKA, ABB, and Fanuc robots also beneficial); power and free and EMS conveyor systems; 480V power distribution, transformers, and distribution busses; and medium voltage level sub-station equipment (considered an asset).

Millwright

With your millwright licence valid in the province of Ontario, you will work on a three-shift rotation to support manufacturing operations. To support factory automation equipment, experience with the following would be beneficial: conveyor systems (including power and free, and power roller table and belt conveyors); hydraulic systems; pneumatic controls (including air logic); machine tool installation (including rigging); and pipe fitting (including design and installation). Computer proficiency is also required.

Candidates must provide certification of qualification, proof of completion of apprenticeship, a copy of their licence, along with their resume. Selected individuals will be required to complete a skill/knowledge-based examination. These are unionized positions and pay and benefits commensurate with local CAW contract.
